Each session is capped at 60 participants with a 5 student minimum required prior to registration closure for each camp.

If the minimum participation requirement is not met, the weekend will be canceled the following day after when registration closed. A full deposit refund will be issued in that case.

Requirements

1. High school students in grades 9-12
2. The Bill of Rights and My Responsibilities essay

Youth Leadership Conference is a nationally recognized, Military Order of the World Wars-sponsored program for high school students.

This conference is for high school-age students in grades nine through 12 advances student's leadership skills through an intense 'hands on' development program. Students will develop leadership skills and learn about teamwork and overcoming communication barriers. You'll also experience life at a senior military college life and how to apply for ROTC scholarships that will help make a college degree affordable.

Activities may include climbing wall training and leadership reaction; lessons will cover the U.S. Constitution and the Bill of Rights, free enterprise and personal finance.

***Essay Contest – What It Means to be an America Citizen** Students interested in the Youth Leadership Conference should submit an essay of 500 words or less titled: "The Bill of Rights and My Responsibilities," describing what these rights and responsibilities mean to you as a United States citizen.

Applications are accepted at any time with or without this essay, however the essay must be submitted two weeks before the start date of each program (Jan. 13, 2023, or March 10, 2023). After registration, you will receive emails instructing you how to submit your résumé.

The Military Order of the World Wars annually selects winners of the national Youth Leadership Conference essay competition from among the top Youth Leadership Conference graduates. The Phoenician Award and cash prizes are presented to the national winner, first runner-up and second runner-up.

Activities may include climbing wall training and leadership reaction; lessons will cover the U.S. Constitution and the Bill of Rights, free enterprise and personal finance.
